THE WHY BEHIND THIS SERIES:

One of the biggest topics facing us in media, online, in education institutions and even in the workplace is around the changing ideas around sexuality. In a time of tinder, hook-up culture, porn, gender fluidity, same sex attraction, HBO, the politicisation of sex and all the gender debates, there are numerous voices clamouring to be heard on these topics. We can find ourselves stuck, not knowing what to say, what not to say, what to believe and what not to believe, when to take a stand and when to show compassion and understanding.

In this conversation it is easy to look around and point fingers at the broken sexuality we see in other people, but, if we are honest, we know that our own sexuality is broken too. No one can claim that they have arrived at a perfect understanding or expression of their sexuality. Many of us are carrying deep and painful wounds around our sexuality, often continuing to do things that cause more harm than health.

But deeper than this, at a personal level, we know that our sexuality has incredible power to form us, to bring health and flourishing, or pain and destruction. It informs how we see and treat ourselves and others around us, as people to be loved or objects for pleasure.

Whether we find ourselves confused, defensive, angry, hurt or even ambivalent, how we seek to navigate through all of this often has more to do with how we see the world than primarily, what we think about sexuality.

Our "God and Sexuality" series aims to explore and unpack the intent of God's design in this wonderful gift of life and sexuality. Knowing that the ways of God in ALL things lead to flourishing, life, joy and healing. We are not looking to pick a fight with anyone but rather show that any difference we may have, most probably, doesn't start with our beliefs on sexuality, but rather our beliefs on God and His intent and design for this world and its people. We are seeking for clarity that leads to healing, life and flourishing. We want to create a place for all people to bring their whole lives including their sexuality to Jesus and let him do the restoring work he needs to do.
